4 X 4 Art Donation Process September 25, 2016

Theme

This year's 4 X 4 theme is "In Tennessee" which compliments and will lead up to next year's theme, "240 Years in Washington County". Washington County will be celebrating their 240th Anniversary in 2017. Since the 4 X 4 artists are painters, photographers, potters, sculptors, fiber artists, mixed media artists, wood carvers, jewelry makers and even film and video creators, the theme may be widely interpreted. How exciting it will be to see anything from landscapes, portraits, architecture, soil, gemstones, plants, animals, and much more that fits "In Tennessee".

Artwork Criteria

The artwork can be 2 or 3 dimensional and must be 4" by 4" in size (un-matted). If the art is projected light, virtual, or made from unusual materials, it must be in a format that patrons can easily take home at evenings end. JCA will matt the majority of the artwork in an attractive and professional manner. JCA has the right to decline artwork that it evaluates as inappropriate.

Where and When

Artwork can be dropped off at Johnson City Arts office, 300 E. Main Street, Suite 302, Johnson City TN, 37601. Drop off times are Tuesdays 10-12 and Fridays 1-3. To locate the JCA office take the elevator to the third floor, make a left exiting the elevator, go through the clear glass door, follow the hallway, and suite 302D is on your left.

Artwork will be received no later than July 30th.
