Friday & Saturday, June 23 or 24: members hang artwork on racks from 9am-4pm

Sunday, June 25: WVAL Summer Show opens with reception & award presentation. All exhibiting members are asked to supply finger foods for the reception.

It was suggested the League could have members who bring new visitors to the show have the member's name be entered into a drawing for a paintbrush set as a way to promote the show. Another suggestion is for members to donate a 4x4 or 6x6 painting as a give-away at the show to encourage more outside visitation to the show. Members can stop by the JC center during a paint-in to pick up a canvas if anyone wants to participate.

4. Sheryl Daniels and Kathy Hawk will be exhibiting their paintings jointly at Art in the Heart Gallery in Kingsport. July 6 is the reception; the show will run through July 29. Gallery hours can be found at Art in the Heart website.

5. Wayne Ritchie announced the Cancer Survivors and Research auction did not take place; therefore, members who supplied paintings for the auction can pick up their art (there is no place to store them at the Park).
