Bill's career highlights include working as an artist for the United States Air Force in Europe, assistant to art direction for Walt Disney/Pipeline Productions and as a freelance artist/designer with NFL Properties. He was recognized as one of the 100 Outstanding Artists of Tennessee by the Tennessee Arts Council in 1991-1992 and Outstanding ETSU Alumni in the Arts in 2013.


