The Roving Gallery has several venues and is in need of participants to display their artwork. The fee is \$15.00 for the year and is due when paying the membership fee. Ken Simmelink and David Kramer are in charge of the Hopland Medical Center and there are currently nine artists showing their work. This venue is for a three month period and will change February 3. This venue has nine spaces available for members to hang six pieces of art each and Hopland Medial Center will take a 10% commission on any piece of art that is sold.
