## Pablo Picasso: Art Thief?

In 1911 Pablo Picasso was accused by Joseph G ry of stealing several Iberian Sculptures from the Louvre. Picasso had the sculptures but, Joseph G ry was actually the statue thief who sold them to Picasso despite them being marked "Property of the Louvre Museum". Unfortunately, the Mona Lisa was also missing and Picasso was questioned about it's whereabouts. The statues were returned and in December of 1913 the Mona Lisa turned up in Florence, Italy. The story was that a Louvre employee stole the painting in an attempt to return it to Italy.
