Watauga Valley Art League Community,

Spring seems to be delayed as we experience a cold March in East Tennessee! Still, there is much to be excited about, and I have some exciting new announcements. Thank you to all those who attended the February general meeting. My wife and WVAL Historian, Brianna Gaetano, and I enjoyed the opportunity to present our methods for capturing the likeness of animals into art and illustrations. For those unable to attend, we once again recorded the meeting for a private YouTube video that will be shared to our email subscribers, so watch your email inbox and follow the included link for an exclusive look at February's meeting!

We are solidifying the plans for our July workshops, of which there are two scheduled for July 1st and July 15th. Christy Ward will be teaching watercolor boutique for the workshop on July 15th from 11 am to 4 pm and will take place in the familiar McKinney Center classroom number 2. Tiffany Saap will be teaching the paint pour technique for the July 1st workshop, but a time has not been scheduled as of yet.

The WVAL has secured a booth for the 2nd year at Johnson City Art Struck, which is scheduled to take place on the first weekend of May in Founder's Park! I'm told that the current construction work will be completed in time for the festival. In preparation, Brianna, Sunny, Myself, and the rest of the board designed a new membership brochure that is cheaper to print and makes it easy for attendees to join the art league. We also submitted an application for a similar information booth at the Covered Bridge Festival in September, but we have not been confirmed as of yet. We will need to have enough volunteers from the league to attend the booth for the duration of the weekend festivals.

Many of our members are developing fundraising opportunities for other community organizations and need volunteer artists from the art league. Watch your emails for more information of how you can help support our charitable efforts in the community. The One Acre Café Gallery Fundraiser has concluded and resulted in \$106.25 for the league. The Artful Treasures Door Prize Fundraiser, managed by Events Director Judy O'Hara, resulted in \$44 for the league, and The Northeast Community Credit Union agreed to purchase a Canvas Sponsorship for \$250, which will support one of our summer workshops. In addition to your membership dues, every little bit helps to secure the future of our organization. Remember to bring cash with you to our upcoming general meeting, so you can have a chance at winning an Artful Treasure to take home with you!

I sincerely hope that everyone is well and that you manage to stay warm while we patiently wait for the warmth and beauty of Spring in beautiful East Tennessee.




