About the instructor: Florida based Artist, Linda Relis, has been painting in oils most of her life. Starting as an interior designer actually helped launch her professional art career. Her work has been shown in

galleries and museums across the country and has won numerous awards and honors. In 2002 she was selected by Florida Gov. Jeb Bush, to represent Florida by creating a Christmas ornament for Pres. & Mrs. George W. Bush's White House tree.

Linda's paintings can be found in private and corporate collections across the United States including The State of Florida's Permanent Collection. Although Linda may be inspired to paint many different subjects, animal art is the closest to her heart. She was inducted into the prestigious

The grey photo is the value scale and the pot that we do to show how the value is applied. SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Chiarosc technique- One stretched canvas 16x20, burnt umber oil paint (I use Grumbacher), 3/4" or 1" bristle brush, odorless turpenoid in a small jar, palette knife, palette, smock, rags or paper towels and q-tips.

Grey Scale and project- One inexpensive canvas board 11x14, one stretched canvas 11x14 or 16x20, 2 more brushes 1/2 and 1/4" bristle. These are approximate sizes for the small, medium and large brushes that will be needed. Titanium white and black oil paint, easel, a ruler and pencil. Students may also want to bring a digital
