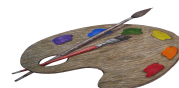

The Kingsport Art Guild Opens Registration for "Explore, Experience and Express" an acrylic and mixed media collage workshop with Toni Carlton. The workshop will be held March 18, 19 and 20 from 10:00 a.m.- 4 p.m. At the Renaissance Center for the Arts, 1200 E. Center St., Kingsport in room 239. Carlton will lead participants through opportunities to explore new techniques using layers of acrylics, gel mediums, paper, fibers and more. They will experience the beauty of using the written word as a prompt to begin their artwork. Expressing awareness along with the mystery of allowing random surprises will stimulate the artists that will free them from traditional painting techniques. Using photo transfers, translucent paints,

graphite, in rice paper and fibers will help create texture in these experiences. Toni Carlton is owner, director and curator of Carlton Gallery near Banner Elk, NC celebrating 33 years in 2015.
